



## WEATHER AT JA MANAFARU

The Southwest Monsoon in the Maldives (also called the “Wet Season”) runs from May to November. During this season there can be some afternoon rain and sudden showers but also many consecutive days of sunshine. On some days during the so-called ‘monsoon’ it doesn’t rain at all or only overnight.

No matter what the weather conditions are, the temperature in the Maldives typically hovers around 30°C and rarely falls below an average of 25°C.

The monsoon raindrops are normally much lighter than those in neighbouring countries such as India and Sri Lanka. It is believed to be due to the low-lying topography and lack of any large landmasses in the Maldives. Typically, the rain showers are sharp and sometimes gusty but can quickly be replaced by sunshine. Additionally, the rain is heavier in the southern atolls some 1,000km distance from JA Manafaru, which is the furthest north resort.

The table below shows the average daily rainfall and sunshine hours of the past four years. Many of the large commercial weather apps take the weather from the whole of the Maldives, we recommend to check the most accurate weather [using this link](#).
